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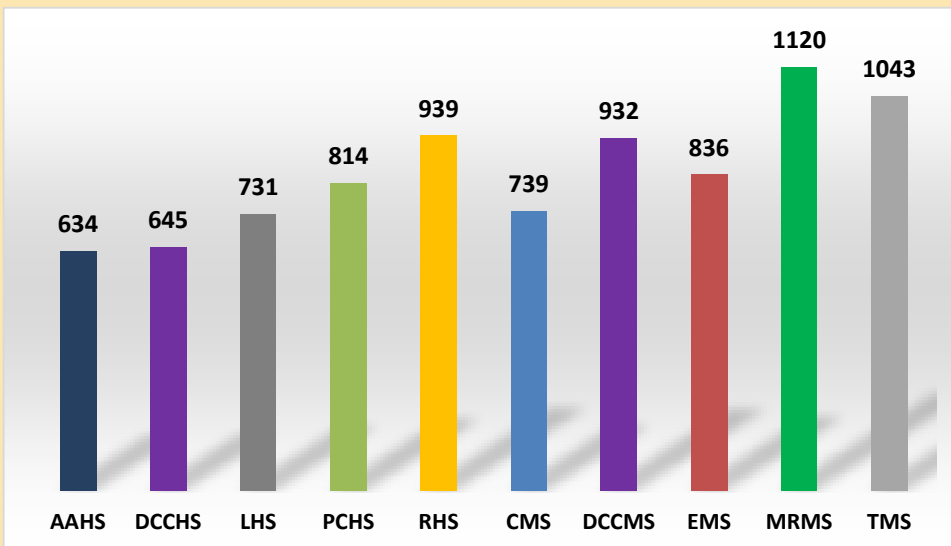

COLLEGE PATHWAYS

D20 provides opportunities for college-ready secondary students to **accelerate learning**. Students can simultaneously meet high school graduation requirements while earning college credit at a significant cost and time savings; students can take courses on the college campus or take high school courses aligned with equivalent college courses.

INDIVIDUAL CAREER & ACADEMIC PLAN (ICAP)

ICAP assists students and their parent(s) or legal guardian(s) in exploring **post-secondary educational and career options**. Students use the Naviance platform to build their ICAPs, which also provide students with the opportunity to align course work and curriculum, apply to post-secondary education institutions, secure financial aid, and ultimately enter the workforce.

SCHOOL TO WORK ALLIANCE PROGRAM (SWAP)

SWAP provides **year round employment services to youth**, ages 14-24, who have a barrier to employment resulting from a mild to moderate disability. SWAP partners with Colorado Division of Vocational Rehabilitation and Colorado Department of Education and is staffed with 1 full time and 2 part time SWAP coordinators based at the EAC.

PROFESSIONAL LEARNING

College & Career Services facilitates **CTE credentialing** courses EDU 250 & 251. These courses are offered through ALEC during the year as well as during the D20 Summer Institute; courses are authorized by CCCS and CDE, and transcripts are provided through D20's The Spot. College & Career Services also supports **ICAP & Naviance training**.

GRANTS

College & Career Services supports the **D20 Education Foundation mini grants** to teachers, maintains a record of all D20 grant activity, provides **guidance for district grant seekers**, and produces a summary of **district grant activity** each mid-year with an update completed in August.
