# Interior Classroom

## Bucket AEES

(Items we would replace with per pupil money)

**Needs:** Replace original furniture due to wear and tear

### Requests:

- Classroom desks and chairs
- Kidney shape tables
- Art room tables
- Staff desks and chairs



### Benefits:

- Increase flexibility for student learning through collaborative groups
- Improve comfort, posture and engagement
- Improve classroom aesthetics



# Interior Non-Classroom

## Bucket AEES

(Items we would replace with per pupil money)

**Needs:** Replace original high use chairs

**Requests:**

- Folding chairs for school gatherings

**Benefits:**

- Teachers, parents and community members use the chairs for assemblies, concerts and other community events



# Interior Non-Classroom

## Bucket ASD20

(Items that will need capital support outside of per pupil dollars)

**Needs:** Replace original high use flooring

**Requests:**

- Carpet tiles in classrooms, office, library and lounge
- Wood floor in gym

**Benefits:**

- Carpet tiles are easier to maintain
- Wood floors in gym are more sanitary and aesthetic
- Teachers, parents and community members use these areas for assemblies, concerts and other community events



# Exterior

## Bucket ASD20

(Items that will need capital support outside of per pupil dollars)

**Needs:** Additional storage for classroom materials and supplies

**Requests:**

- Storage shed-storage space for portable classrooms

**Benefits:**

- Increased student learning space in portables





# Considerations from IT

(Items that will need capital support outside of per pupil dollars)

**Needs:** Replace projectors and original mounted TV's

**Requests:** Smart TV's in each classroom

**Benefits:**

- Supports schools interactive curriculum
- Allows for multiple teaching approaches
- Improve flexibility in the classroom
- Increase teacher and student engagement
- Encourage student collaboration and participation



# Considerations from Facilities

- Reduce maintenance and water consumption
- Provide usable, safe playfield year round
- Increase field use and rental income

**Needs:** Replace wooden ramps on portable classrooms

**Request:** Aluminum ramps on portable classrooms

**Benefits:**

- Reduce maintenance
- Increase aesthetics
- Increase durability
