One School, Three Programs

- The Village-Hybrid program for 9th & 10th grade
- Extended Studies-Supplemental program for D20 students
- Access Program-Completely online program for students who need an independent, remote learning opportunity

Current Facility Upgrades

- The Village program is currently housed in a borrowed modular classroom on the campus of Pine Creek High School. As we enroll 50-70 students for the 2016-2017 school year, we need an additional modular to accommodate our students
- The Extended Studies program and The Access program are housed in office space at the Education and Administration Center that is borrowed from the D20 Learning Services Department.
- Because we don't have any permanent space of our own, we don't have any requests for facility upgrades at this time.

Future Facility Needs

- As all three programs continue to grow, we would like to request a permanent space
 - The Village Program has grown from 0-50 students in 2 years and the plan is to continue to grow our student population until we reach a student population of approximately 200 students in grades 9-12
 - Extended Studies currently serves approximately 225 students in the school district through online and hybrid courses. We would like a classroom to house hybrid courses in the future
 - We would like to collaborate with other programs in the district to create an Innovation and Learning Campus
