# General Improvement Needs (Per Pupil Allocation Funds)

- ▶ Outdoor seating at athletic venues
- ▶ Theater Upgrades (LED lighting and Sound)
- ▶ Gymnasium Upgrades (Floor, AV/Sound Systems)
- ▶ Classroom Technology Upgrades (Touch Projectors)
- ▶ General Storage
- ▶ Hand Dryers in restrooms
- ▶ Outdoor Classroom

# Capital Improvement Needs- Construction

- ▶ Classroom Space: DCCHS has a utilization capacity of 1,140 students. Enrollment during the 16/17 s.y. will be 1200 with another 1,120 high schools students projected to move into our area by 2022.
- ▶ Auxiliary Gym- DCCHS is the only High School without an auxiliary gym.
- ▶ Additional Parking- DCC has reached capacity in parking.
- ▶ Restroom facilities on Athletic Fields- it is 0.3 miles from the track to the nearest restroom in the building on a steep grade.
- ▶ Artificial Turf Field
- ▶ Fencing- There is currently no fencing around the school grounds or athletic complex.
