Special Education Needs in New Buildings

New Buildings

- Rooms for center-based programs (Significant Support Needs, Affective Needs, Communication/Social Delay)
 - Rooms require bathrooms with changing tables
 - Itinerant work space (social workers, occupational & physical therapists, speech language pathologists, psychologists, vision & hearing teachers)
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Preschools in New Elementary Schools

- Elementary Schools include preschool rooms (30 square feet per child)
 - Separate entry
 - Bathrooms w/ changing table in classroom
 - Separate playground
