Pathway availability varies by high school. With the exception of ASCENT, students earn high school and college credit. College credits and grades earned in high school become part of a student's permanent college record. College course credits may transfer in congruence with Colorado Guaranteed Pathways; otherwise, transferability of credit is not guaranteed.
