	<b>ASCENT PPCC</b>	ASCENT provides qualifying high school seniors with the opportunity to stay enrolled in high school for a fifth year while they concurrently enroll in an approved post-secondary institution. 	<b>CE Academics PPCC/UCCS</b>	Qualifying students needing a course that is not offered in D20 concurrently enroll at UCCS (including MathOnline) or PPCC and earn high school and college credit. Academy 20 pays tuition at the prevailing on-campus community college rate.
