

## Find Your Pathway

The primary goal of Academy District 20's College Pathways is to provide opportunities for college-ready secondary students to **accelerate learning**. Students may earn college credit at a **significant cost and time savings** by taking courses on the post-secondary campus or by taking high school courses aligned with equivalent college courses. Students may also earn credit by participating in robust national programs including Advanced Placement® (AP) and International Baccalaureate (IB).

Academy 20 not only works with each student to tailor a meaningful plan for life after high school, but also sets student dreams in motion with access to a full menu of post-secondary options.

### High School Instructor Pathways

Students may enroll in high school courses that are aligned with a local post-secondary institution and taught by approved Academy 20 teachers to earn dual college and high school credit.

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#### 2016-17 Tuition

- PPCC: \$10 per course
- UCCS: \$75 per course (CU Succeed), \$102 per credit hour (Project Lead the Way)
- UC Denver: \$75 per course
- CSU Pueblo: \$52 per credit hour

#### Courses

More than **40** Academy D20 classes have been articulated with a post-secondary institution. Courses vary by school. See your teacher or counselor for course availability and policies at your school.

### College Instructor/Campus Pathways

Qualifying college-ready students may enroll in one of the programs listed below to earn dual college and high school credit. These courses are regular post-secondary courses taught by college or university instructors.

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#### 2016-17 Tuition

- Area Vocational Pathway: \$75 application fee
- ASCENT: \$75 application fee
- CE Academics: Varies (D20 pays the tuition at the prevailing on-campus community college per credit hour rate. Students pay the remaining balance, campus fees, and textbook costs).
- CU Succeed Platinum: \$75 per course
